The Summer Stage Combat Workshop at Ohio University is an introduction to creating the illusion of violence for stage and screen. This workshop will:

- Cover the basics of safely performing stage combat.
- Teach fundamental skills that promote safety and dramatic effectiveness.
- Teach specific techniques in multiple theatrical weapons such as broadsword, knife and single sword.

Short scenes will be developed and presented on the last meeting day for family and friends.
